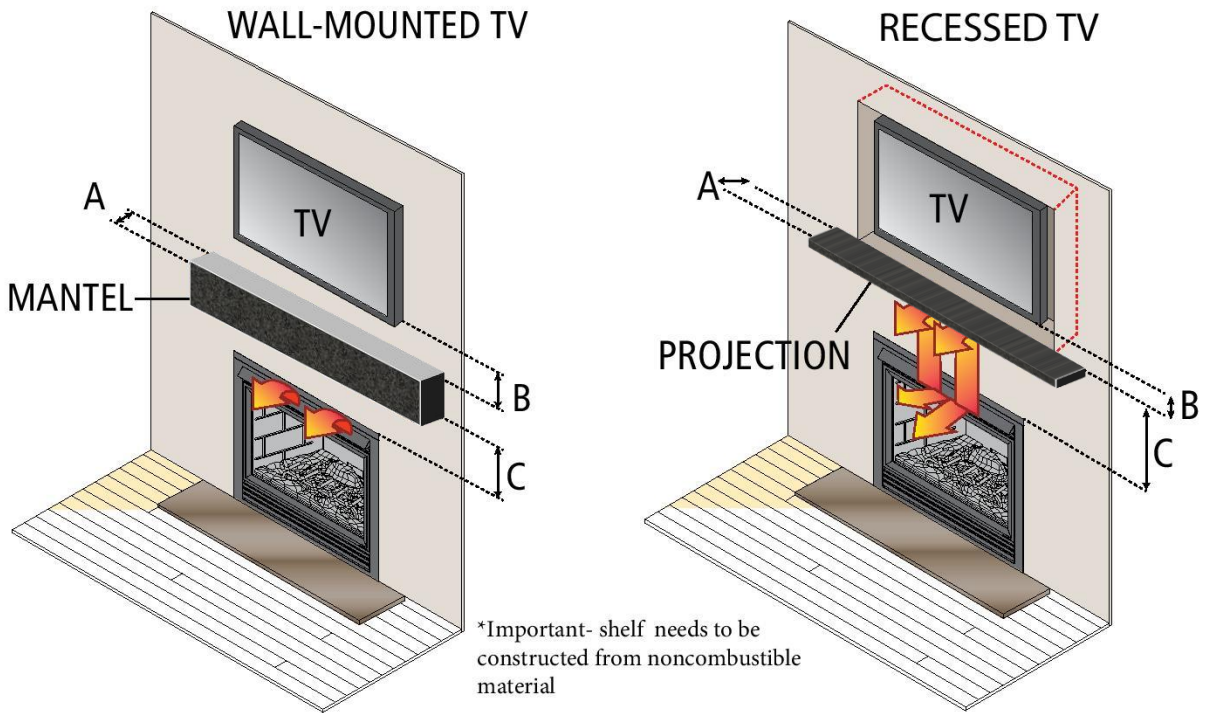




# Can I mount a TV above my fireplace?

Yes! Many people mount their TV above the fireplace. The main objective is to redirect the heat away from the TV.



\*Important- shelf needs to be constructed from noncombustible material

**A.** Minimum mantel/projection beyond face of TV, of 50mm

**B.** TV should be above mantel/projection, 50mm

**C.** Minimum of 125mm from top of fire to underside of noncombustible shelf

## Notes

1. These are good faith recommended clearances only and not a guarantee of compliance with all TV manufacturers' maximum allowable operating temperatures. If installed like suggested above there will be minimal heat generated onto TV above shelf.
2. "C" dimension taken from the top of the hood or fireplace opening.
3. Suggestions on how to further reduce TV temperatures:
  - a. Increase "A" dimension.
  - b. Increase "C"
